Teri is working to find a way to cluster student petitions, so the committee does not have review them at every meeting. She is working with Mike Gimlin and will be reaching out to Scott Carlton to work on this process.

Arturo indicated that there can be an IS representative that can come to meetings, if necessary, to help through some of the discussion around logistics of General Education and the computer systems.

Committee discussed the issue of courses moving from one knowledge area to another.

Two proposals are in the system, but the dean has not yet approved them. The committee can chose to review it, deny it or have it wait until next year.

Teri asked that committee members review proposals from their review group and the committee will break into their groups next week to work together on the proposals.
