Discussion Item(s)- Update

The Space and Equipment Budget Subcommittee decided to wait until Spring (or later) to send out the survey asking Faculty about their technology needs in the classrooms they teach in because Faculty is mostly working from home due to COVID.

Discussion Item(s)- General

The Subcommittee was shown the Summit Engineering A/V Standards and discussed how different classrooms have different technology needs. The current struggle is that new buildings are being built with the newest technology, but the older buildings are not being updated at the same rate. Faculty and Administrators need to have better communication regarding technology needs and budget.

The group discussed the need for a sustainable equipment/technology update plan. There are 157 general classrooms and 163 department owned classrooms:
