Head of household	under 65	\$18,000
	65 or older	\$19,600
Qualifying widow(er)	under 65	\$24,000
	65 or older	\$25,300

**Gross income means all income received in the form of money, goods, property, and services that isn't exempt from tax, including income any income from sources outside the U.S or from the sale of your main home (even if you can exclude part or all of it). Do not reduce income by any losses
