Monthly Summary

AUAP最後の月はハイライトとなる出来事が多かった。留学中に取り組んできた様々なプロジェクトが完成され、学生達に英語力、自信、文化認識、そして積極性の向上が実感された。AUAPのキャプストーン・プロジェクト（学んだ事をまとめ上げ、身につけたスキルを実際に使う活動）がジョブ・フェア。このイベントのために学生達はアメリカ形式の履歴書と留学中に伸ばしたスキルや強みを示す「国際体験ポートフォリオ」を作成した。様々な会社が設定され、一人2つの会社へ模擬面接を受け、採用されるようにリーダーシップ、問題解決力、文化認識をアピールしていた。ディスカバリー・プロジェクトのプレゼンテーションも大きな誇りと自信をAUAP生に持たせた。学生達は9月に決めたトピックについて研究とインタビューを行い、それを発表した。このプロジェクトを通して学生は個々のトピックについてミニ・専門家になり、質問にも対応した。難しいプロジェクトだが、完成する時に5ヶ月間の成長と英語力の強化に気づく。

January Class Highlights

The final month of AUAP was full of highlights for the students! Many of the projects that they've been working on all cycle came to completion allowing students to see and feel their English improvement and growth in confidence, cultural awareness, and positivity.

The capstone project for AUAP is the AUAP Job Fair. Students created an American style resume and an International Experience Portfolio to showcase their strengths and skills that they developed through studying abroad. Students interviewed with two different fictional companies and shared examples of leadership, problem solving, cultural awareness and more as they did their best to get jobs. Members of the CWU and Ellensburg community volunteered as interviewers and were so impressed with the depth of the interviews and students' AUAP experiences.

The Discovery Project presentations were another highlight that left the students feeling proud and confident. Students shared the findings of their interviews and research around a topic that they chose back in early September. After months of discovery, students have become mini experts on their topics and were able to respond to audience questions as well as present their findings. This project, while difficult, really enables students to see their personal growth and English improvement over the past 5 months.

AUAP生がCWUを去る2月11日の前、多くの行事やアクティビティーがあったが、中でも成人式とAUAPナイト、各寮での最後のアクティビティー、そしてお別れ会が大きなイベントだった。1月30日の成人式では、思ったよりの来客に9人が大人になったことをお祝いしていただいた。それに続き、AUAPナイトで全ての学生がダンス、ビンゴ、居合道、クイズ、歌などの出し物を披露した。全部で11組が舞台上で演奏した。そしてアンバサダー賞に挑戦している5人が自分の体験についてプレゼンテーションを行った。CWUの友達への感謝と別れの気持ちを示す良い行事だった。お別れ会は帰国する前夜、5ヶ月のアメリカ経験を振り返る感動的なイベントだった。各クラスレベルを代表する学生のスピーチ、修了証書そして皆勤賞と最優秀成績賞の授与が行われた。さらに5月間のハウス・カップ競走の優勝チームが発表され、アンバサダー・アワードを取得した3人の学生に金メダルが渡された。最後にIPAをはじめ、スタッフがお別れのパフォーマンスをし、45分間のAUAP体験のドキュメント映画を上映した。心に残る夜になったことでしょう。
