To remain eligible for the waiver, students must remain in full-time status (ie: enrolled in at least 10 credits of which at least 5 credits must be of 501 or higher).

Academic Fellowship

Award is eligible to students based on an applicant's last 90 graded quarter, or 60 semester hour, cumulative GPA. Which must be a minimum of 3.25)

Leadership / Meritorious Service Fellowship

Award is eligible to students who have served in leadership roles within their community, college, or professional organizations.

Diversity Fellowship

Awards is eligible to first-generation college students or applicants who have a history of overcoming disadvantage. Fellowships are also available for students with diversity experiences who contribute significantly to the quality of CWU's graduate programs. Awards are also available for those nominated by diversity-focused organizations outside of Central Washington University.

Candidates granted probationary admission are not eligible. To be eligible applicants must have a minimum last 90 graded quarter credit cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of a 3.0 (3.25 for Academic Merit nominees).
