- Diversity Awards-Discussed new speaker possibilities and new date. Diana Fischel-Hall will put out the information to the community requesting a community member nomination with a March 4th deadline. Currently there are 20 nominations. 15 out of the 20 nominations are for 15 different individuals and they include faculty, staff, and students; no community members. New Diversity Award possible dates last two weeks in April or 1st week of May. (May 5th is Celebration of Science and Polyfest) CWU is shortlisted for Ta-Nehisi Coates for next year; possible replacement this year: Spike Lee.
- Gail Farmer and Richard DeShields provided information on the Intercultural Development Inventory (IDI) Conference that they attended in January. - Student-Diversity Statement passed; the students produced a video.

The rollout of the new signs and gender neutral bathrooms will start with one restroom and eventually expand to having all restrooms gender neutral. This entails individual stalls with full length doors to maintain privacy.
