Physical Education	
Note that PE credits in college may be 1 - 2 credits which equal 0.2 or 0.4 HS credits College PE classes count only if they are performance based, not classroom courses	
Vocational Education	
Most 100- or 200-level ag, business, computer, tech or occupational courses will count. Check with counselor for approval.
