Resolution on Removing Faculty and Staff as Voting Members on the S&A Fee Committee
Drafted by the ASCWU President on 5/16/2021
Modified by ASCWU BOD on 2/16/2022

WHEREAS Central Washington University’s Services & Activities Fee Committee is comprised of 13 voting members with 3 of them being faculty members, 1 administrator from the President’s cabinet, and 9 students,

WHEREAS students are assessed a quarterly S&A fee intended to support student success through extracurricular activities, resources, and support services,

WHEREAS faculty, staff, and administration are not assessed this quarterly S&A fee,

WHEREAS having faculty as voting members presents a power differential which can and does influence the votes of student voting members on the S&A committee,

BE IT RESOLVED the S&A committee should only have students as voting members since faculty, staff, and administration do not pay the fee,

BE IT RESOLVED that the faculty and administrative members are removed as voting members on the S&A committee,

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that S&A Committee should increase the number of student representatives to 13 students, including the ASCWU Executive President.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that advisor and the chair of the S&A fee committee look at best practices within Central Washington University and its values for having faculty, staff and administrators serve as voting members on this committee,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that CWU administration and S&A fee committee maintain communication with the Associated Students of CWU with the progress of this resolution.
