A maximum of 5 credits of elective, lower-division Coursework may be counted towards the minor. SOC 490, Cooperative Education and SOC 496, Individual study, do not count towards the minor. For electives you may use any sociology course, except for those noted above.

*You may not apply sociology minor courses to any sociology/social services major unless you are dropping your minor and adding the sociology or social services major in place of the minor. Sociology 107 is required for most sociology/social services majors and minors and is the only class that can be taken once and used for both the majors and the minors as a required course, not an elective.

*Soc 369 Mass media and Society is a 4 credit Course, if you select this course as one of your 20 elective credits you will need 1 additional credit to complete this Sociology minor.

*Formally ETS 101, students may not receive credit for both
