Reports

They plan on presenting to the rest of the WSA board to see if we can switch a fee model from \$1 to \$2.

Grace and I are working on putting a funding request for the dunk tank, which is priced at 1,300. We are looking at getting merchandise as well. As well as Massive shoutout to **Senator Campbell** for her Cozy Crochet and Crafts event, we had close to a 200 person turn out and was an amazing event. We have received a request to hold the event again, for it was really well liked by the students who attended. All the senators have begun planning their events, all of them are being scheduled for Spring Quarter. I want to work with publicity on creating a section in the Spring Hype for all the senator events.

Speaker Hondo has received confirmation from Christina Denison from the Douglas Honors College to serve as a counterpart for the new DHC senator position that we are working to create.



The Senate will be discussing and voting on this position, which if passed, will come to the BOD next week. **President Cantu, Vice President, Senator Wyman and Speaker Hondo** are planning on meeting with Dean Rodrigo on the hooding ceremony to decide how we will move forward. Finally, we are finalizing an academic class module survey for students; this will be used to share with the Provost to decide what modules we want to have more of in following years. This survey will only be shared with students attending classes on the Ellensburg campus.
