Speaker Hondo wondered about the ability for the BOD to strike someone's pay as a method of concern if a director is not doing their job, a bit unethical. **President Cantu** noted that this section is just a guideline for in the unfortunate future how to address someone who may not be doing their job. **Speaker Hondo**—please add further clarification or just strike “public censure” as he believes it could conflict with the bylaws. **President Cantu** mentioned that inevitably if it were to happen in the future the council would get brought in and tell the board what is and isn't “public censure”. **Director Garcia-Sanchez** wanted to add a subsection as to what it is, and the ability to not be able to take away the board's right to vote. Lola added that the “public censure” is just a public statement stating that the board does not approve of actions/decisions from whatever director made them`.
