Director Francis – Do we have information about his experience?

EVP Matheson – I want to emphasize the importance of these appointments, especially because I can't vote on them

Speaker Parrazal Bravo motions to approve **Heru** as a part of the committee, seconded by **Director Oulcaid**, voting was messed up

Speaker Parrazal Bravo motions to do a roll call vote

Emilio – We have prior knowledge from his interest forms, and they passed rounds of approvals

Director Francis – I was under the impression that we're voting today

EVP Matheson – We are going to vote to the best of our abilities, also **S&A** doesn't require a budgeting background. I believe that Heru is competent due to reading their reasoning for applying.

Speaker Parrazal Bravo – **The Senate** asked similar questions that **Director Francis** asked, and the Senate decided to **move forward** with the candidate. Heru also does have a budget background and experience with people here.

Director Francis – I appreciate the information.

President Hondo – The constitution determines the system that we are using to vote.

Director Francis – I was wondering if this was a blind vote or not, so I appreciate the clarification

Emilio – **The Senate** would like to be involved in this process earlier

Rueben – They are giving testimonies in real time, and that is what they stand for

President Hondo – There were written statements, and the recorded testimony is what we should be looking at

Marisol Torres Alcanter – Services and Activities Fee

Marisol Torres Alcanter's testimony video was shown to the board of directors

EVP Matheson - gives context that the vote for this candidate during the Senate meeting was **6-9**, but the vote was **counted wrong**, and the board should **disregard the count**.

President Hondo - this candidate is a vital voice for the groups she'd be allocating money to.

Speaker Parrazal Bravo - gives context to the abstention of Hadley obtained and due to the bylaws, there needs to be a full vote from the senate, but it wasn't caught until the end. Though they didn't pass the vote, this mistake should allow the board to give their full attention to this candidate

Director Francis - if under the abstentions should they still vote

President Hondo - they were told they passed even though it was through a mistake, it's unfair to not consider them due to this and they look past the error.

EVP Matheson - there was some errors in the senate either way so there's no way around it

Director Francis - with the bylaws can we do this?

President Hondo - yes because the mistake wasn't caught until after the meeting ended
