The motion “*Approve Committee Recommendations*” passes with 8 votes in the affirmative and 3 abstentions due to absence by roll call vote.

Speaker Johnson presents “Grievance Filed by Student Regarding Issues within Dining Services Cont.”. There is continued discussion regarding students’ issues with Dining Services. He reports the hiring numbers and additional information that was requested at a previous meeting; he states that there are currently 380 student employees working for Dining, 200 of which started between this September until now. 50 of the 200 are considered in training, which started within the past two weeks. Dining is currently looking to fill the 10:00am to 2:00pm service hours, as well as the additional 50 to 75 positions that need to be filled. He also discusses what onboarding covers, which includes going over the student handbook, key policies, workplace safety, etc.

- **Senator Hondo** states that he spoke to several students who both want to be and don’t want to be anonymous – main concern is the lack of communication between upper management and its lower leaders; very difficult to understand who follows in the chain of command
- **Senator Gordon** wonders what the range of solutions the Senate has to address this issue and what the timeline is; **Speaker Johnson** states that starting a sub-committee to look into possible solutions to bring to dining could be created (could allow for conversation to continue in less structured environment), write letter of support, bring in Dining reps to discuss the issues - timeline depends on the option you pick – states that, regardless of the option chosen, **Speaker Johnson** will be bringing in higher-ups from dining to discuss these issues
- **Senator Worrall** states that he’s spoken to several people within dining, they are well aware of the numbers issues, however communication is difficult, Dining is always trying to get numbers up
- **Speaker Johnson** states that he’s informally talked with Dining higher-ups about these issues, and they are aware of them, however, do not necessarily know how to solve them
- **Senator Worrall** suggests tabling this discussion and establishing it as a recurring agenda item; **Senator Hondo** says that we shouldn’t discuss this again until a conversation is had with a dining rep
- **Senator Hondo** motions to table this discussion until a conversation can be had with a Dining representative, seconded by **Senator Cordon**
