Staff Attire Policy

Our program encourages staff to wear a professional/business work attire. We do understand, that we are still providing exceptional early learning experiences on a university campus and all of our employees need to portray this in their work attire. Our work is very unique in that we are lucky enough to get to have play as part of our day.

You may wear jeans that are in good repair. They must cover your backside when bending over and may not be ripped or torn.

- RAINBOW CENTER: You may wear dresses. These need to be just above the knee in length and you need to be able to bend over in them comfortably and still be covered. Rainbow Center will be required to have leggings on underneath their dresses- not tights or nylons.
- You may wear shorts that are mid-thigh in length. These cannot be athletic-type shorts and cannot contain rips or holes.
- Tops must cover your bra straps and your cleavage. They also must be of sufficient length for bending over. No racer back tops.
- <u>Yoga pants, athletic wear, sweats, or other exercise attire is NOT appropriate</u> <u>wear</u>.
- Leggings must be worn with a longer top and must be in good condition. These cannot be athletic in style or material. <u>No sheer or no mesh</u>.
- You may wear tennis shoes, sandals, boots, and flip flops. You may not go barefoot at any time. Shoes should be of a type that you can run, jump, and dance in.

**We have aprons and smocks available to wear to protect your clothing, Rainbow center uses these daily.
