## COMMUNITY GARDEN

The Community Garden at the Wildcat Neighborhood Farm promotes community health and well-being by allowing participants to practice growing food and resilience. The Community Garden is mostly volunteer-run and receives limited funds through the CWU Services and Activities Fees.

The Community Garden also serves the CWU and greater Ellensburg community through educational programs, by growing food specifically for food pantries and by encouraging experimental growing methods on a smaller scale. Donating to the Community Garden supports new growth in the program.
