

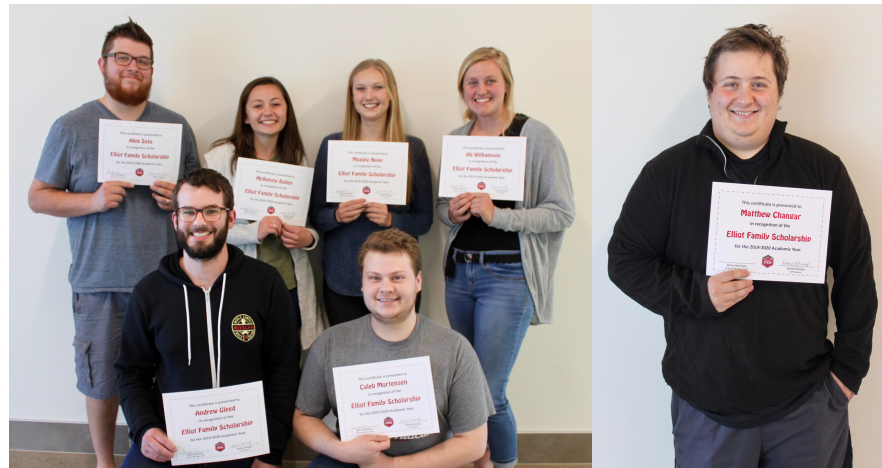
Thank you for your sponsorship of a scholarship awarded to students majoring in a science education related field with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
