ACTION – New Degree, Bachelor of Arts in Non-Profit Organization Management

The BA in Non-Profit Organization Management provides students with an in-depth understanding of, and preparation for, careers in the non-profit sector. The curriculum is aligned with the 10 core competencies of the [Non-Profit Leadership Alliance](#), a leading organization of non-profit education programs nationally.

The competency areas include

1. Communication, Marketing, and Public Relations;
2. Cultural Competency and Diversity;
3. Financial Resource Development and Management;
4. Foundations and Management of the Non-Profit Sector;
5. Governance, Leadership, and Advocacy;
6. Legal and Ethical Decision Making;
7. Personal and Professional Development;
8. Program Development;
9. Volunteer and Human Resource Management; and
10. The Future of the Non-Profit Sector.

Administered by the College of Arts and Humanities, the BA in Non-Profit Organization Management is an interdisciplinary program that provides students opportunities to take courses from, and engage in cooperative education/internships in, the College of Arts and Humanities, the College of Business, the College of the Sciences, and the College of Education and Professional Studies.

The Faculty Senate approved this new degree program on June 1, 2016 (Motion No. 15-56).
