CWU-WENATCHEE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ DTA Associate degree, or completion of CWU general education requirements, or bachelor's degree from any accredited college or university
- ❖ Prerequisite courses* completed – **minimum grade of C** (see below)
- ❖ Passing Scores on West B Exams or SAT/ACT equivalent
- ❖ Minimum 3.0 GPA for last 45 credits earned
- ❖ At least 40hrs of documented time observing/assisting in a k-12 classroom** (satisfied by EDUC 210)
- ❖ One year of foreign language (high school and/or college) - Waived for bilingual candidates

Application Process

1. Meet with a CWU-Wenatchee representative early in your college career to discuss application requirements and dual admission.
2. Schedule an appointment with the Yakima Education program advisor to develop a plan for completing admission requirements and prerequisites.
3. Apply for Admission to CWU – Priority Deadline March 1st.
 - ❖ See a CWU-Wenatchee representative for assistance on applying to CWU.
4. Apply to Teacher Certification Program – Priority Deadline April 1st.
 - ❖ Meet with program advisor for teacher certification application and next steps.
 - ❖ You do not need to have completed admission requirements before applying.
